NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

LUNCH BREAK will be scheduled at the judge's discretion.

FOOD: Water will be available for purchase. Don't forget to bring shade and a chair.

ENTRIES:

A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog entered. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Entries WITH-OUT fees and signatures on Entry Form will NOT be accepted.

Same day entries will be accepted only 1 hour before testing begins. If you don't bring the enclosed entry form with your check, then you will need to allot time to fill out an entry and pay for the test before you run.

ALL OVERNIGHT OR REGISTERED MAIL MUST WAIVE SIGNATURE!

No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of CCWCC will be made after the closing date.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date. After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of CCWCC it is impossible to open or complete the Test classes, no refund will be made.

CCWCC may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against CCWCC or any official thereof.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the test classes and will run in catalog order in the trial classes. Please notify the test secretary as soon as possible so schedule adjustments can be made.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except while in the test arena. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena – this includes BARKING dogs. All dogs must be kept at least 20 feet from arena fences during test runs. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club HERDING REGULATIONS.)

BE CONSIDERATE – CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!

DIRECTIONS

From the North: Take I-97 South off the Baltimore Beltway. Exit New Cut Road. Turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow approximately 1.5 mile to fork in road. Bear left onto Gambrills Rd. Go approximately 2 miles to flashing red traffic light and turn left onto Dicus Mill Rd. Turn right at the second street, Ski Lane.

After 3 houses, the main road turns left and the driveway to 470 continues straight ahead. Follow the signs to the far back of the property keeping the wire fence to your left at all times. Please note that the drive is circular. Do not exit the way you came in. Continue on past the RV parking to the exit.

From the Annapolis or Bowie: Take either Interstate 97 north or Rte 3 north to Rte 32 west. Exit Burns Crossing Road. At the end of a long ramp; turn right at the traffic light onto Burns Crossing. Take the first immediate street on the right, Dicus Mill. Go approx two miles to stop sign and flashing yellow light, continue straight and follow the directions above to Ski Lane.

From the West: Take Rte 32 east to Burns Crossing Road. Turn right at end of ramp. Right at first traffic light, then left at next light onto Burns Crossing. Turn right onto first immediate street, Dicus Mill and follow directions above.

From Washington DC: Take either Interstate 95 or the Baltimore Washington Parkway north to route 32 east, follow above instructions from the west.

From Severna Park: Take Benfield Blvd west to four way stop sign; turn left onto Najoles Rd. After 1 mile Najoles turns abruptly right and changes names to Dicus Mill Rd. Continue approx 1.5 miles further to a left onto Ski Lane. Follow directions to site above.
